Critical thinking in the classroom is a common term used by educators Critical thinking has been called "the art of thinking about thinking" (Ruggiero, VR, 2012) with the intent to improve one's thinking The challenge, of course, is to create learning environments that promote critical thinking both in the classroom and beyond
